- A graveyard at the Wescam entrance with the names of hundreds killed in Iraq and Afghanistan
- A "War is a Preventable Disease" affinity group will provide free and safe inoculations against militarism.
- Citizens weapons inspectors will check the grounds for violations of international and domestic law.
- Individuals dressed as Guantanamo Bay detainees will remind Wescam employees what torture looks like

- Makes targeting equipment for some of the world's deadliest weapons systems.
- Supplies human rights violators: Colombia, Egypt, Algeria, China, Iran, Libya, Saudi Arabia, U.S., and U.K.
- Builds components used by Hellfire-missile-armed US Air Force Predator, Cobra Attack Helicopter, "low-cost precision kill" vehicles
- Provides "border control" products that prevent refugees from finding safety
- Outfits police forces to repress demonstrations and "public disturbances"
